

The twelve regular channels are arranged in pairs (energetic couples).

There are 6 pairs, each one formed by a Yin channel (attached to a Yin organ) and a Yang channel (attached to a Yang organ), and each pair corresponds to one Elements.

Bladder Channel (Yang)

Wood Element:

Liver Channel (Yin)
Gallbladder Channel (Yang)

Fire Element:

Heart Channel (Yin)
Small Intestine Channel (Yang)


Pericardium or Master of Heart (Yin) Triple Burner Channel (Yang)

Large Intestine Channel (Yang)

















PERICARDIUM (MASTER OF HEART) CHANNEL


